

R.C. Miessler is the Systems Librarian at Gettysburg College and is one of the facilitators of the library's Digital Scholarship Summer Fellowship.






Courtney Paddick is the Arts and Humanities Librarian at Bucknell University, and co-facilitator of their Digital Scholarship Summer Research Fellows program.



Lafayette: origins & beginnings

Essential question:

How can the library directly support and encourage digital scholarship? How do we bring this good work to the heart of our mission, undergraduate students?



Lafayette: form & evolution

Cohort model: selected for the strength of their idea and their desire to learn. Work toward independent goals but collectively.

Competitive, paid internship.

8 students, 6 weeks, *their* projects start to finish.

What has changed:

Year 2: added a paper element; embedded more library instruction; greater emphasis on contextualizing within current scholarship.

Year 3: formalized a "bring-it-back" component. Started orientation and prep work earlier. More collaboration with other programs.



Assignments

(1) Research Process

Proposal, thesis (with project included), annotated bibliography, lit review, methodology, analysis, conclusion. Entire draft 1, draft 2, final paper.

(2) Project Building

Digital Humanities definitions, digital project review, tool review, tool demo, project draft 1, final project, presentations

(3) Reflection

Weekly reflection on readings, frustrations, successes. Promoting assessment and a culture of openness.

Inspiration from student activity at #ILiADS15 and #BUDSC15






Gettysburg: Logistics

10 weeks, paid, library-led, student-centered

Open curriculum: anyone can remix, reuse

Process emphasized as much as final project

Development of a community of practice

Connecting with more institutions and expanding the community



Funding from Mellon grant and student wages




